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7 The petition in writing of *J. E. Beck*
8 and others, was on this ~~28th~~ day of June, A. D. 1908, presented
9 and read to this Board, asking the Board to call an election
10 for the formation of the "Carmel Sanitary District" and the
11 election of officers therefor: *J. J. Davando*
12 and *Charles Clark* were duly sworn and

13 testified before the Board that more than twenty-five (25) of
14 the persons whose names are signed to said petition, specifying
15 the name of each of said twenty five and more persons, are
16 residents and free holders in the proposed district. Said wit-
17 nesses also testified that the signatures to the petition were
18 each and all the genuine signatures of the persons whose names
19 are signed to said petition, and the Board being fully satisfied
20 that the petition is in due form as required by law ~~and~~ so finds
21 the same to be: that the names attached to the petition are the
22 true and genuine signatures of the persons whose names are signed
23 thereto, and that twenty five and more of said persons so signing
24 said petition are residents and free holders in the proposed
25 district,

26 Therefore upon roll call a resolution is unanimously
27 adopted as follows:

28 RESOLUTION and ORDER fixing the day of election for
29 the purpose of determining the formation of a Sanitary District
30 within the County of Monterey, State of California, to be known

1 as "Carmel Sanitary District", showing the boundaries of said
2 proposed district and stating that at said election persons to
3 fill the office of Sanitary Assessor and five members of the
4 Sanitary Board will be voted for:

5 WHEREAS, twenty five persons and more within the County
6 of Monterey, State of California, all being residents and free
7 holders within said proposed "Carmel Sanitary District" have
8 presented a petition in writing signed by them stating that they
9 desire the formation of a Sanitary District within said County,
10 the name of said proposed district, setting forth the boundaries
11 thereof, and praying that an election be held as provided by an
12 "act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled "An Act
13 "to provide for the formation, government, operation and dissolu-
14 "tion of Sanitary Districts in any part of the State, for the
15 "construction of Sewers and other Sanitary purposes; the acqui-
16 "sition of property thereby; the calling and conducting of Elections
17 "in such districts; the assessment, levy, collection, custody and
18 "disbursement of taxes therein, the issuance and disposal of the
19 "bonds thereof, and the determination of their validity, and making
20 "provision for the payment of such bonds and the disposal of their
21 "proceeds" Approved March 31, 1891, and all the Acts amendatory
22 thereof, and supplementary thereto:

23 AND WHEREAS ~~witnesses were sworn and their evidence~~ *and the Board finds it as a fact*
24 taken before the Board establishing the facts, that more than
25 twenty five of the persons whose names appear on said petition
26 actually signed the same, and that their true and genuine signa-
27 tures are appended thereto, and that each of them is a resident
28 and a free holder within the proposed District:

29 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of
30 Supervisors of the County of Monterey, State of California, that

1 an election be held as provided by said Act of the Legislature,
2 within said proposed district hereinafter particularly described,
3 on ~~Friday~~ ^{Monday}, the ~~13th~~ ^{14th} day of July, 1908, the polling place to be
4 at the office of Phillip Wilson, on Ocean Avenue, in Carmel-by-
5 the-Sea, Monterey County, California, within said proposed
6 district, in said County and State, to be known and designated
7 as "Carmel Sanitary District"; and for the election of officers
8 of said proposed district provided by said Act, to-wit: five
9 members of the Sanitary Board and a Sanitary Assessor!

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following officers be,
11 and they are hereby appointed to conduct the election for the
12 proposed "Carmel Sanitary District", to be held as aforesaid,
13 to-wit:

14 INSPECTORS *John P. Staples* and *L. S. Slewin*
15 JUDGES *J. W. Havel* and *Sydney J. Yard*
16 CLERKS *C. J. Arue* and *J. S. Burnight*
17 BALLOT CLERKS *R. H. Feidig* and *Walter Hansen*

18 That at said election the tickets or ballots shall
19 contain the word "~~For a Sanitary District~~" or "~~Against a Sanitary~~
20 "~~District~~", as the case may be, and the name of a person for
21 Sanitary Assessor, and the names of five persons for members of
22 the Sanitary Board.

23 AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the boundaries of said
24 proposed district be, and the same are hereby, designated and
25 set forth as follows, to-wit:

26 All that certain portion of the County of Monterey,
27 State of California, particularly described as follows, to-wit:
28 Beginning at station E-P-I of the El Pescadero Rancho, said
29 station being on the southeasterly line of the El Pescadero
30 Rancho, where said southeasterly line strikes the Carmel Bay:

1 thence along the Southeasterly line of said Rancho N. 60° 48' E.,
2 2484.43 feet to a wooden monument standing on the Westerly line
3 of Lincoln Avenue, Addition No.4 Carmel-by-the-Sea; thence North,
4 337.46 feet; thence East 260.05 feet; thence North 450.04 feet:
5 thence East 250.04 feet; thence North 450.04 feet; thence East,
6 610.10 feet; thence South 609.07 feet to a wooden monument stand-
7 ing at the intersection of the Southeasterly line of the El
8 Pescadero Rancho and the East line of Junipero Avenue, Carmel
9 City; thence along the said Southeasterly line of the El Pescadero
10 Rancho, N. 60° 48' E., to a point where said Southeasterly line
11 intersects the Westerly line of the Rancho Canada de la Segunda;
12 thence along the Westerly line of said Rancho Canada de la Segunda,
13 southerly, to the Northerly line of the lands of Mrs. Elizabeth
14 Martin; thence along the Northerly line of lands of said Martin,
15 westerly, to the Easterly line of Mission Street as the same is
16 shown in Addition No. 2, Carmel-by-the-Sea; thence along the
17 Easterly line of Mission Street, South, to the Northeasterly line
18 of the County Road leading to Carmel Mission; thence along the
19 said County Road, Southeasterly, to the Southerly line of Santa
20 Lucia Avenue, as shown in Addition No. 2, Carmel-by-the-Sea;
21 thence along the Southerly line of said Santa Lucia Avenue,
22 westerly, to a point where said Southerly line intersects the
23 East line of Carmelo Avenue, as said Carmelo Avenue is shown in
24 Addition No.I, Carmel-by-the-Sea; thence S. 23° 50' W., 573.2
25 feet; thence S. 13° 06' W., 1172.75 feet; thence S. 19° 28' E.,
26 173.56 feet; thence S. 35° 20' E., 330 feet; thence S. 0° 07' W.,
27 453.7 feet; thence S. 87° 36' E., 289.1 feet; thence S. 4° 31'
28 E., 276.8 feet to a point in the center of the Carmel river;
29 thence S. 87° 35' W., 565.5 feet to a point on the Carmel Bay;
30 thence along the shore of said Carmel Bay Northerly to the place

1 of beginning.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this order be posted
3 for four successive weeks prior to the said election in three
4 public places within said proposed district, and be published at
5 least once a week for four successive weeks prior to said election
6 in the *Monterey New Era* a newspaper of general
7 circulation printed and published in the *proposed district* city of Monterey, County
8 of Monterey, State of California, there being no newspaper pub-
9 lished within the proposed district. -

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
